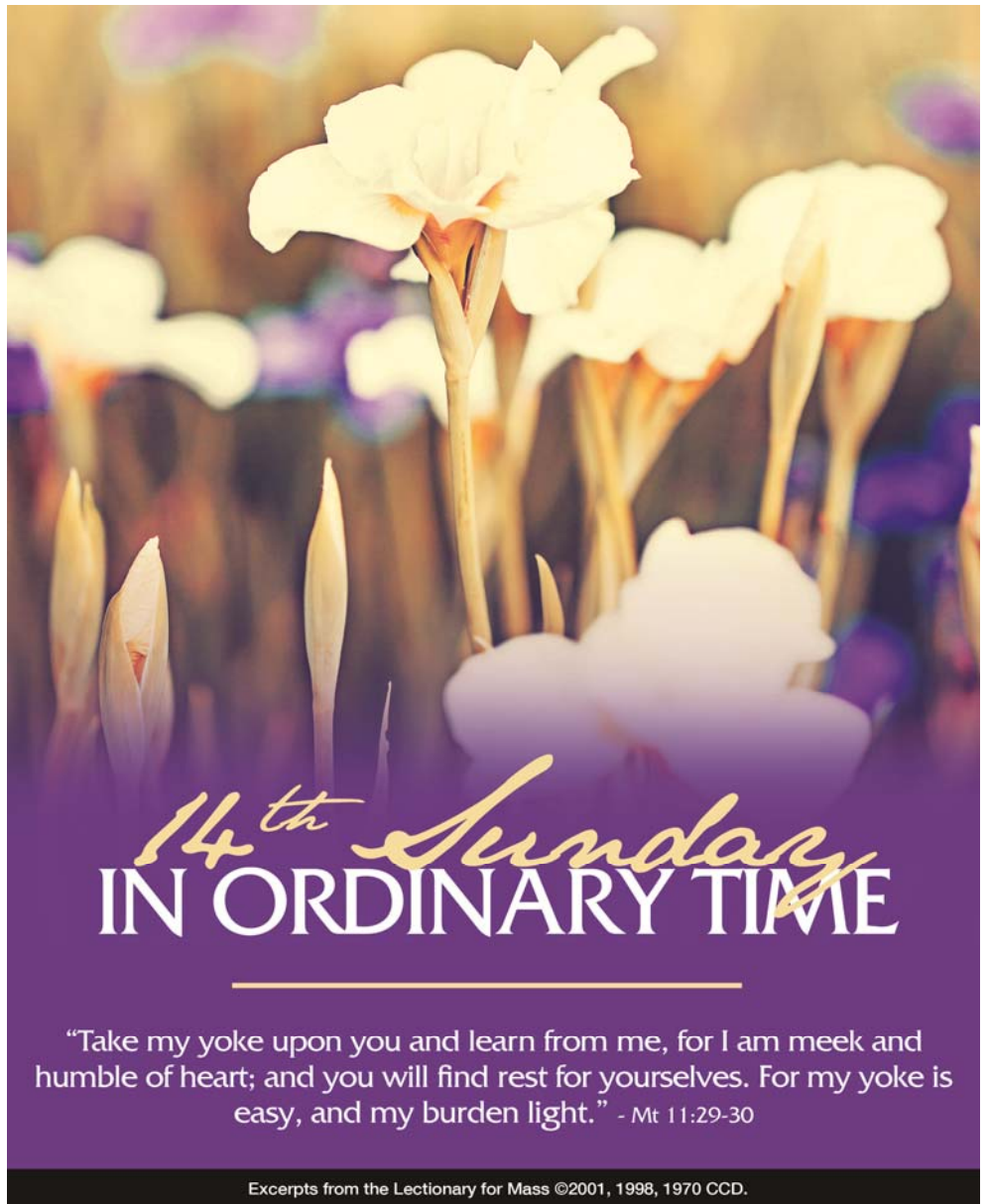

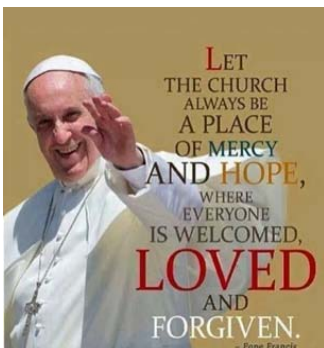

Trends don't have the final word. You can positively impact the next generation simply by sharing from your heart.

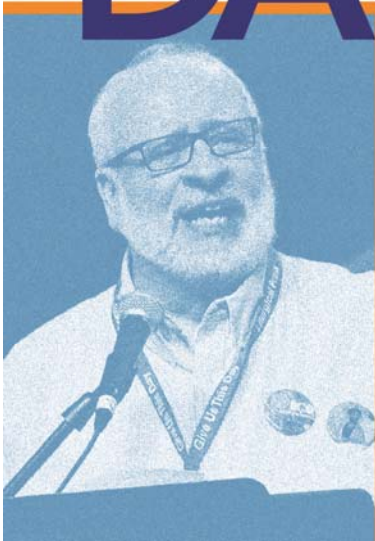
